The Ministry of Community Safety and Correctional Services seeks a Chaplain for the Thunder Bay Jail.

You will provide spiritual and religious care programs to offenders, their families and staff at the Institution, including coordinating the community faith groups in their provision of spiritual and religious care within the Institution. Coordinating and administering the Volunteer Program, including monitoring the activities of community volunteers active within the institution, and maintaining good relationships with local faith community leaders will also be important aspects of this role. In addition, you will provide leadership in developing and sustaining worshipping communities within the Institution and promote and monitor issues from a spiritual and religious perspective relating to the value system that maximizes humanization in the care of offenders.

Qualifications: knowledge of other faith groups and modes of religion, normally acquired by a combination of university, theological school, and three years professional experience or equivalent; ability to relate with community faith groups and their leaders, and the Ontario Multifaith Council toward establishing community oriented or based programs, including recommendation from the Ontario Multifaith Council on Spiritual and Religious Care; ability to provide comprehensive spiritual and religious care programs to offenders, their families, and staff, and understanding of the operations of correctional institutions and the legislation under which they operate; ability to plan, organize and implement spiritual care programs and religious services; demonstrated administrative skills, guiding and training students and other spiritual and religious visitors, as well as established communication skills to deal with residents, their families and staff.
