The Ministry of Community Safety and Correctional Services, Office of the Chief Coroner, is seeking to fill the position of Regional Supervising Coroner, North Region, Thunder Bay Office.

The successful applicant for this position will provide professional consultative services including providing direction and supervision to coroners within the region; coordinating and directing investigations and inquests; presiding over unusual or complex inquests; maintaining effective liaison with pathologists, police, crown attorneys, lawyers, media, and the public; and performing duties of a coroner, as required.

Qualifications: medical degree and license to practice medicine in Ontario; management and leadership skills to plan and coordinate consultative and investigative activities and to direct the operation of the regional office; knowledge of and ability to interpret relevant legislation and guidelines when conducting death investigations and/or inquests, such as the Coroners Act, Trillium Gift of Life Act, Anatomy Act, Vital Statistics Act, normally acquired through experience as an Investigating Coroner and regular ongoing education; communication skills to liaise and collaborate with internal and external stakeholders, including medical and legal professionals, law enforcement agencies and the media, as well to prepare and disseminate information in the form of memorandums, newsletters and media releases; knowledge in the fields of general and forensic investigation techniques, as well as extensive experience in the practice of medicine; knowledge of court procedures and other quasi-judicial responsibilities (including rules of evidence) to preside over inquests and hearings, and issue subpoenas and warrants for seizure.
