You will provide comprehensive health care and nursing services on an assigned shift. You will provide clinical nursing services, individual counseling, prepare and dispense medication, provide emergency first aid, establish and maintain factual medical charts and records as well as be responsible for nursing assessments, individual and group educational sessions and assist with relevant health care reintegration planning. You will also contribute to a multi-disciplinary team approach in the provision of services to youth. You will work 21.75 hours per week in this part time position.

Note: The headquarters will be moved upon the commissioning of the new youth centre in Thunder Bay.

Qualifications: current registration as a nurse in Ontario and maintained annually; knowledge of nursing theories and practices as well as good nursing assessment skills; sound communication skills to interview residents and articulate medical instructions and provide information to youth regarding health issues or concerns; demonstrated understanding of relevant issues related to working with teens and young adults such as Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder (FASD), drug and alcohol dependencies, abuse, eating disorders and mental health issues; proven interpersonal skills and ability to work as a member of a multi-disciplinary team; knowledge of youth development processes, theories and approaches; proven presentation and facilitation skills; basic computer skills to prepare reports and input and retrieve youth's information; willingness to work shifts.
