If so, consider bringing your culinary expertise to the Ministry of Children and Youth Services` new Thunder Bay Youth Centre. As Shift Cook, your primary role will be to prepare, cook and serve nutritious and appetizing meals for youth and staff on an assigned shift. You will be responsible for inspecting eating facilities and equipment to ensure hygiene and safety standards are maintained, ensuring adherence to prescribed menus, work schedules and dietary charts, substituting menu changes and supervising the serving of and proportioning of meals as well as purchasing food and supplies and maintaining an inventory within a budget. You will also participate in the programming for youth by teaching skills and providing opportunities for the youth to learn about food preparation. This is an on-call position, working from 0 to 40 hours per week.

Note: The headquarters will be moved upon the commissioning of the new Youth Centre in Thunder Bay.

**Qualifications:** thorough knowledge of food preparation and storage techniques and procedures and proper kitchen equipment operation normally acquired through completion of post-secondary education in chef or cook training course or related work experience; demonstrated experience in volume cooking such as within an institution or commercial setting and ability to prepare special diet meals; knowledge of safe food handling practices and food service sanitary requirements; proven communication and interpersonal skills to instruct, train and supervise youth kitchen workers; experience in maintaining food inventory and financial management skills to purchase food and supplies and remain within budget; willingness to work shifts, weekends and holidays.
