As Regional Health and Safety Advisor, you will work as a member of a multi-disciplinary team to assist ministries in ensuring work is performed in a safe and healthy manner and in compliance with relevant legislation, policies, and procedures. This role requires you to provide advice, technical assistance and expertise to managers, supervisors, workers, human resource business units, and the Joint Health and Safety Committee system. In addition, you will conduct/coordinate hazard assessments, and provide health and safety advice and interpretation to ensure compliance with Ministry of Labour (MoL) orders. You will also provide education/training to employees, and implement proactive approaches to accident prevention by reviewing statistics, analyzing trends, and monitoring workplace conduct.

Qualifications: knowledge of the Occupational Health and Safety Act and regulations, pertinent sections of other relevant federal and provincial legislation and codes, such as Transportation of Dangerous Goods, Building Code, and Fire Code, and industry best practices; demonstrated experience conducting hazard assessments, and reviewing and making recommendations on health and safety practices and compliance, as well as knowledge of ergonomics, safety, industrial hygiene, and occupational illnesses; communication skills to interview employees, provide advice, and prepare/present reports and training materials; experience related to health and safety service delivery, as well as analytical and problem solving skills to conduct investigations of workplace accidents, identify hazards, and assess compliance; interpersonal skills to promote acceptance of occupational health and safety programs, and assist workplace parties with compliance issues of the Occupational Health and Safety Act and regulations.
