In your role as Fire Services Supervisor, you will supervise the provision of logistical services and support to the regional and provincial fire management program including administration, forest fire equipment maintenance and development, inventory and control, and facilities management at the Provincial Logistics Centre. This position offers challenging leadership opportunities in coaching the development of staff and building effective relationships with staff, various outside agencies, suppliers and other government personnel. You will provide support to daily fire and emergency response operations through the management and provision of the regional equipment recycle program. You will prepare operational plans and annual work plans for building maintenance and equipment management, assist in long range planning for service and support areas and liaise with Ontario Realty Corporation (ORC) to ensure adequate site and plant maintenance, security services, day-to-day operations of the provincial logistics centre complex and work with ORC on the design and construction of capital facilities and projects.
