Sleeping Giant Ontario Ranger Camp is located in Sleeping Giant Provincial Park, approximately 90 kilometres east of Thunder Bay. This all female camp has up to 24 Ontario Rangers, four assistant supervisory staff and two cooks. Ontario Rangers spend their two month work term working at various resource management jobs at the park and at various locations outside the park. Lodging and meals are provided to supervisors at the camp for free.

As a member of the Sleeping Giant Ontario Ranger team, under the general supervision of the Park Superintendent, you will oversee the implementation of the Ontario Ranger work, education and recreation programs and the day-to-day administration of the camp. You will also carry out maintenance and operation procedures and the safety program of the camp.

Qualifications: proven leadership and supervisory skills to provide motivation and guidance to a group of Ontario Rangers and camp staff and to monitor progress; effective organizational, judgment and decision-making skills to oversee projects, assess quality and volume of work, ensure compliance to program policies and procedures, ensure safe working conditions and implement daily activities; good communication and interpersonal skills to provide instructions and performance feedback to Rangers and camp staff, liaise with management, other ministry staff and stakeholders, and prepare reports; good understanding of and interest in resource management principles and techniques; demonstrated experience in canoe tripping, camping, navigation and practices/techniques of outdoor living; basic knowledge of building and facility maintenance; knowledge of and ability to operate and maintain a variety of office and light equipment (lawnmowers, brush saws, boats, small hand tools); demonstrated ability to work independently and follow and carry out instructions; knowledge of Ministry of Health standards applicable to preparing, serving and storing of foodstuffs, meals, utensils and drinking water; knowledge of the relevant sections of the Occupational Health and Safety Act that apply to the work being performed; good computer skills to maintain records and prepare reports; ability to work shifts, weekends and statutory holidays; valid Pleasure Craft Operators Certificate or ability to obtain; valid class "F" driver's licence to transport rangers.
